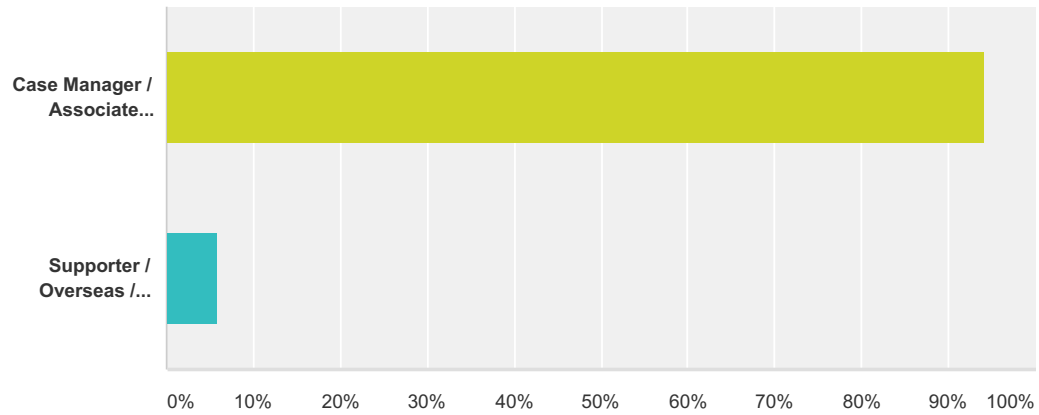

Q1 Which membership type do you hold?

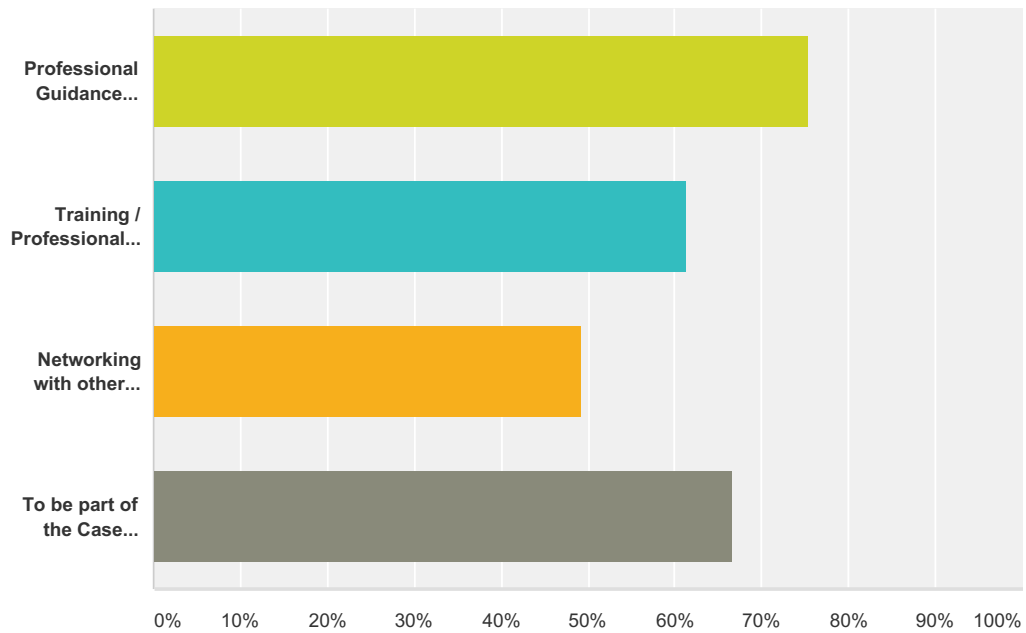

Q2 What attracted you to CMSUK Membership?

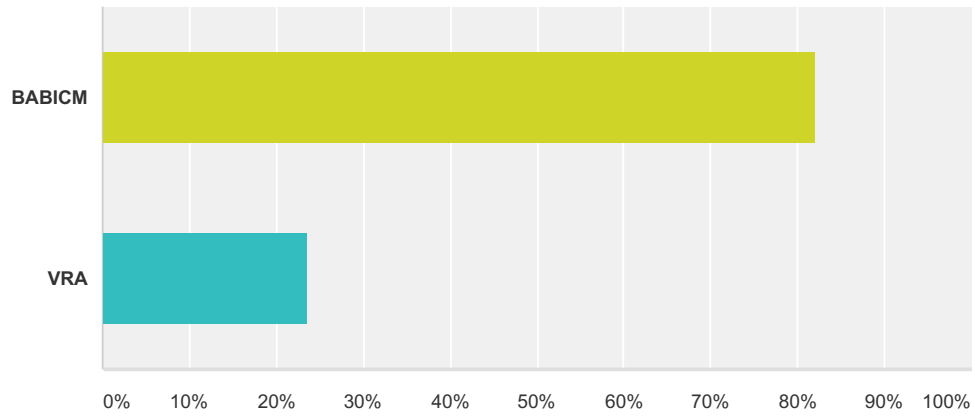

Q3 What other Case Management organisations are you a member of?

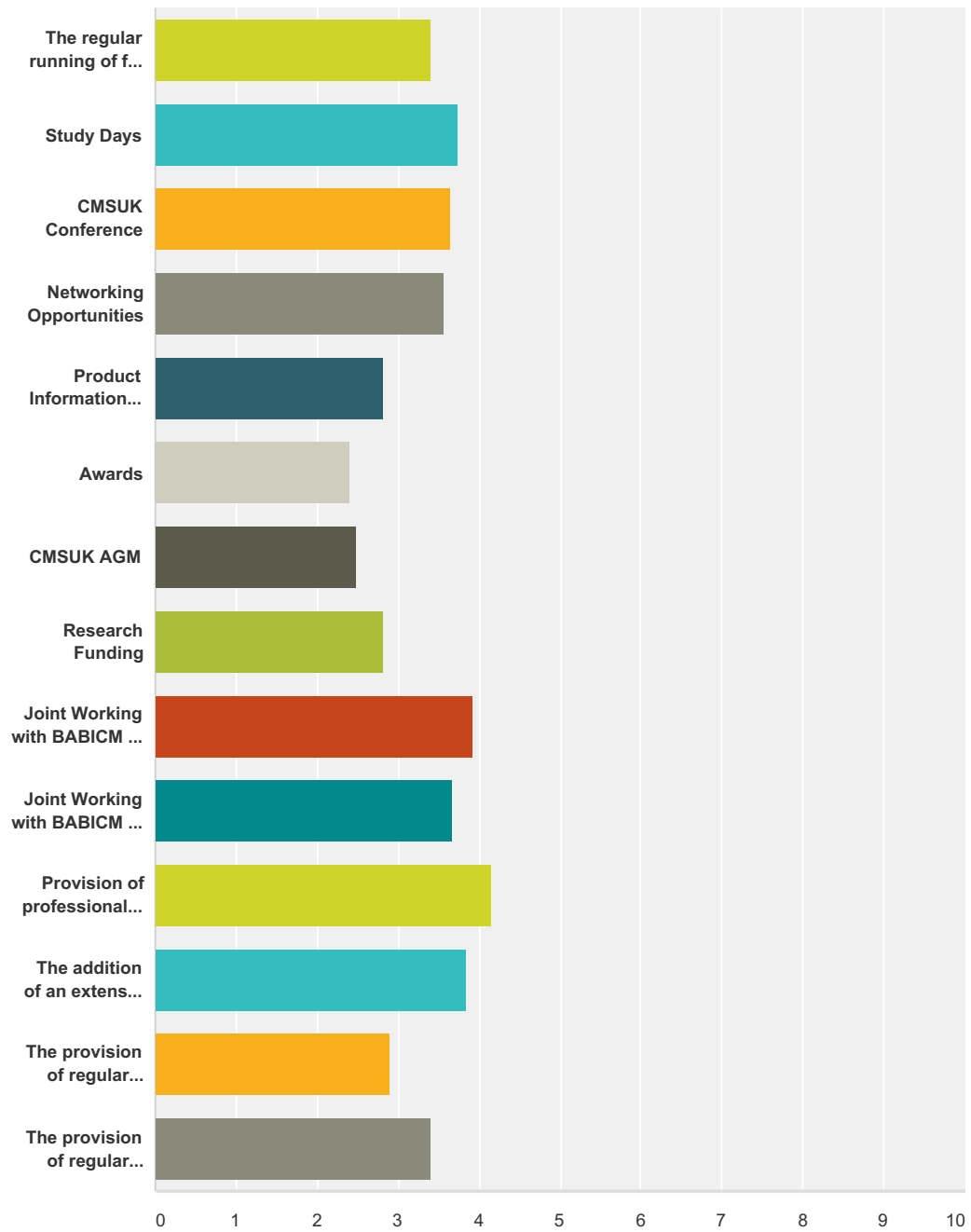

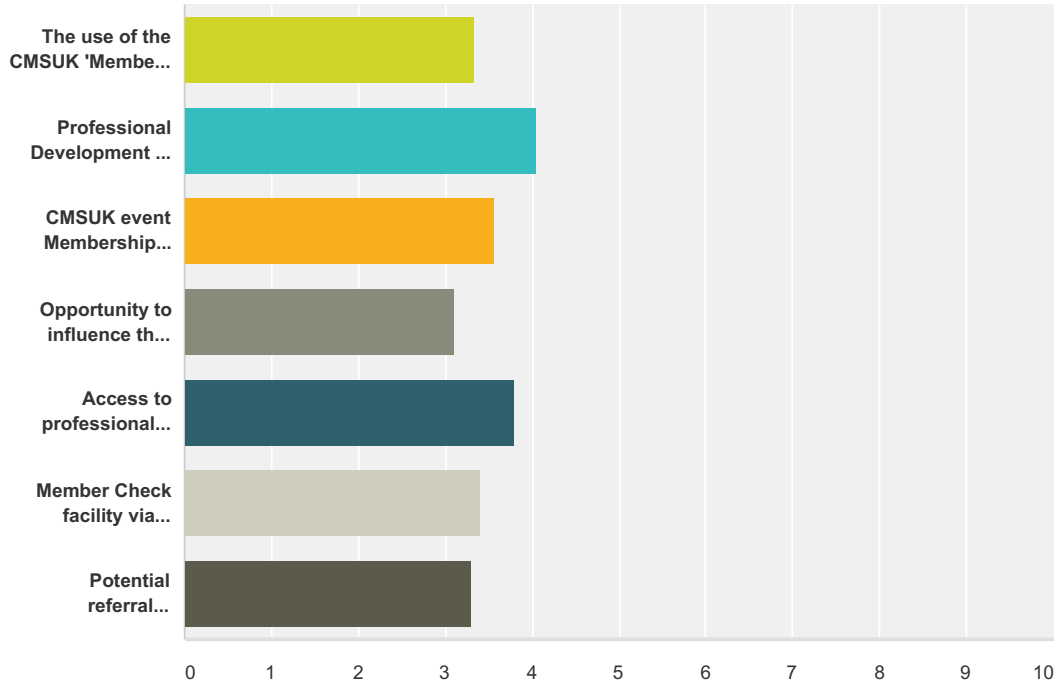

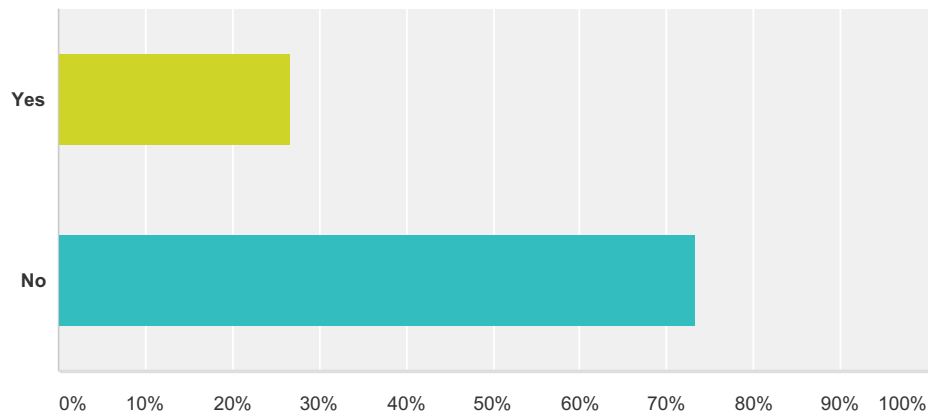
